

Following the direction of the Kansas Department of Health and Environment, Tonganoxie Recreation Commission will be closing some facilities and canceling programming until further notice. Affected facilities include:

- Public Restrooms at Chieftain Park
- Playground at Chieftain Park
- Basketball & volleyball courts at Chieftain Park
- All facilities at TRC ball field complex

In addition to the facility closures, TRC will be canceling all classes and events scheduled for the time being, as well as our Spring Soccer league, Short Sports, 4U soccer and our annual Easter Egg Hunt. All outdoor sports team practices have also been canceled.

TRC is working on plans to credit and/or refund any classes with dates scheduled during these closures. We are confirming the details of this process, and we ask for patience as we coordinate this process. Participants in programming will be notified of the process at a later date.

Chieftain Park will remain open, pending further direction from the KDHE. The public is welcome and encouraged to utilize the walking trail and grassy areas. TRC's office will also remain open. We ask that when using these facilities patrons utilize social distancing practices and remain 6ft apart from other patrons.

We realize the inconvenience these closures may cause to members of our community, but your health and safety has always been – and will continue to be – the priority of Tonganoxie Recreation Commission. We will continue to follow all recommendations by public health agencies to mitigate the spread of this virus. Any changes to the closure will be announced as decisions are made.
